Information Sheet

Hi to all members -

As autumn ends and winter approaches, we are writing this update while busy making gritting and snow ploughing arrangements for the winter. The weather men have made no secret of the forecasted hard winter coming up so if you are able to offer gritting or snowploughing or indeed require these services then please get in touch with the ring office.

If the wet weather sees you doing paperwork, why not try the automated system on the members section of the ring website - www.lothianmachineryring.co.uk - it really is very straightforward and much quicker than posting work tickets to us. If you would like to try the online system for the first time then feel free to phone the office and we would be happy to talk you through it.

The increase in fuel ordering through the Ring has continued throughout the year, and if you don't currently order your fuel through the Ring, why not phone the ring for a quote for all your fuel supplies, you have nothing to lose!

On the subject of fuel, many of you will be aware that from January 2011 Gas Oil, (red diesel), must contain less than 10 milligrams of sulphur per kilo of fuel (ie virtually sulphur free). The reason for this is to meet EU cleaner air quality emissions requirements.

Gas oil used for heating or stationary equipment will not change however some fuel suppliers may for logistical reasons choose to supply sulphur free gas oil for these applications as well.

Road Diesel (derv) is already sulphur free and it is anticipated that suppliers will supply the new style of Gas Oil as Road Diesel but with the red excise marker dye added. As Road Diesel already contains some Biodiesel (up to 7%), Gas Oil by default will also have 7% Biofuel in it. You may not however be aware that this new mixture requires improved storage 'housekeeping' arrangements. It is recommended that the contents of a tank are 'turned over every six months, and certainly every year. This may have implications for those members who may leave fuel for long periods, eg in a grain dryer. There is a possible solution to this problem in the form of additives and the ring has suppliers who have this additive available to members. Please see the ring website (www.lothianmachineryring.co.uk) for the full EU Directive.

With regard to communication, more and more ring members have asked us to continue exploring communication with members by email. We have been trialling this system for some time now with a large number of members and it has been very successful. If you are not currently receiving information by this method and are now able to, please let us know by emailing jenny@lothianmachineryring.co.uk and we will add you to the growing email distribution list. This is proving to be a quick and cost effective way for the ring to keep members up to date with news and special member offers.

Following the innovative new deal with S.M.R.A. (Scottish Machinery Ring Association), we are delighted to report that in the second year of operation (which ends 30th Nov) we already have 9 members eligible for a rebate from CASE IH.
